Over the past hundred years, SSDM has touched countless lives through a wide spectrum of initiatives. It has run schools, including Bat Valley School, for Ugandan children, organised medical camps and blood donation drives, and hosted the Annakshatra programme, which provides food for all. It has served as a parental body for other temples across Uganda, managed cremations, and

through rituals with compassion. Hindu festivals have been celebrated with grandeur, while the Bal Sanskar Shala has instilled moral values and cultural teachings in children. An active Mahila Mandal and vibrant youth programmes have strengthened community bonds, and in earlier years, a community library and clinic extended its reach even further. Every Saturday, the temple resonates with the recitation of Hanuman Chalisa, followed by prasad served to over 400 devotees.
