We partner with the Lions Club of Nairobi - Huru to ensure every blind child and adult has access to quality education and the tools they need to thrive.

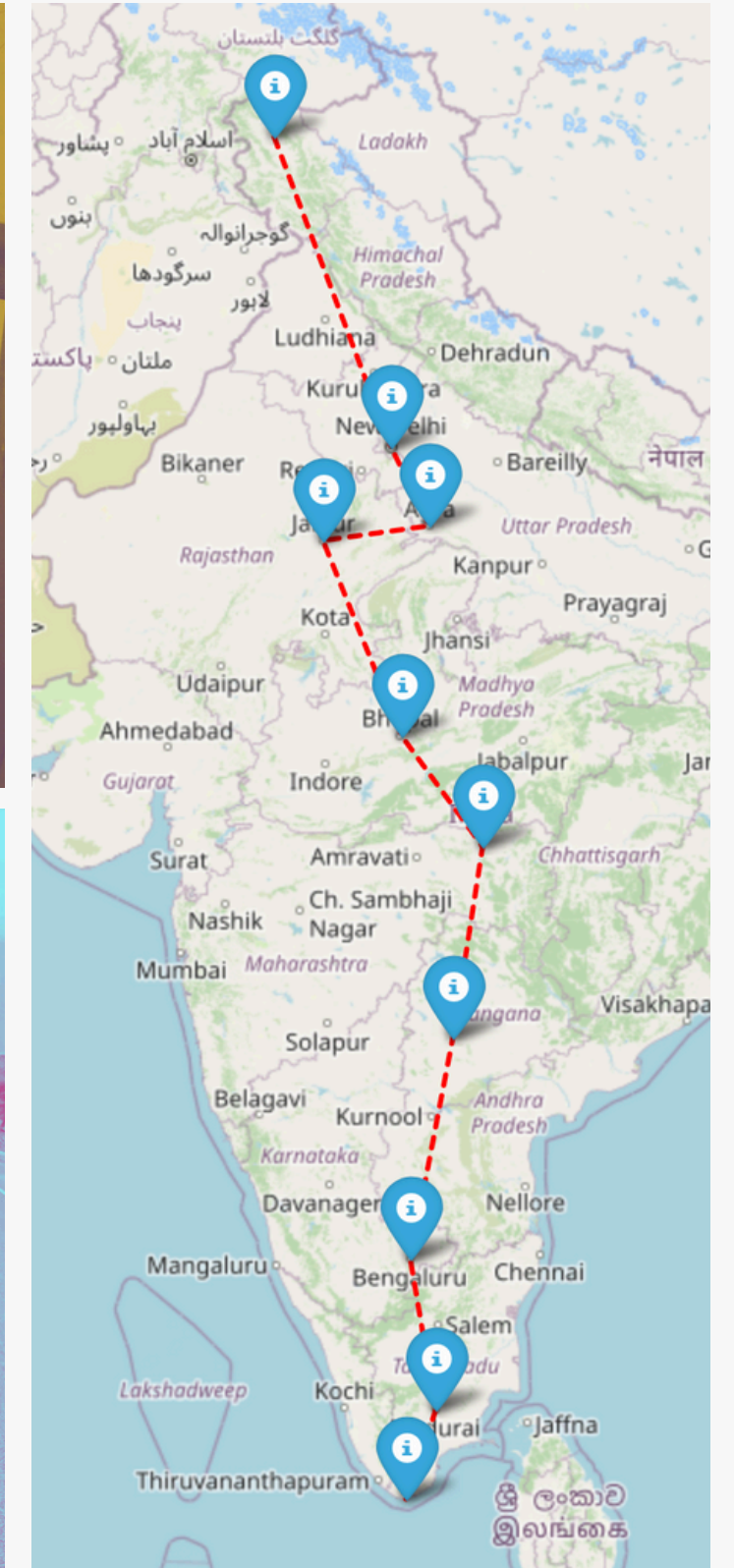

ABOUT THE RIDERS AND THE EPIC CHALLENGE

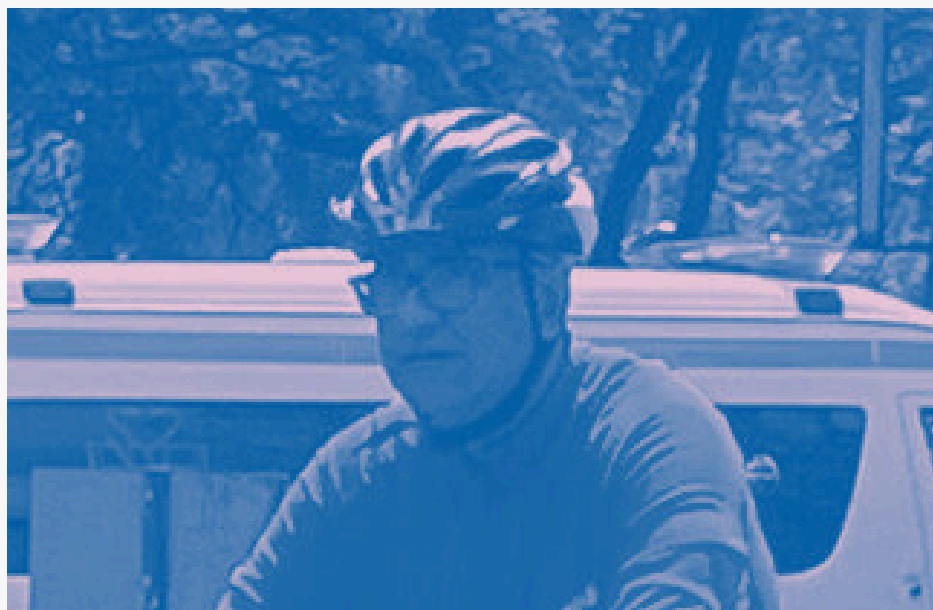

Covering 11 states in just 3 weeks. This epic challenge is a test of endurance, determination, and commitment, traversing diverse terrains and weather conditions. The route will take them through the Himalayas, plains of northern India, central highlands, and southern coastal regions, making it one of the most challenging rides ever attempted.

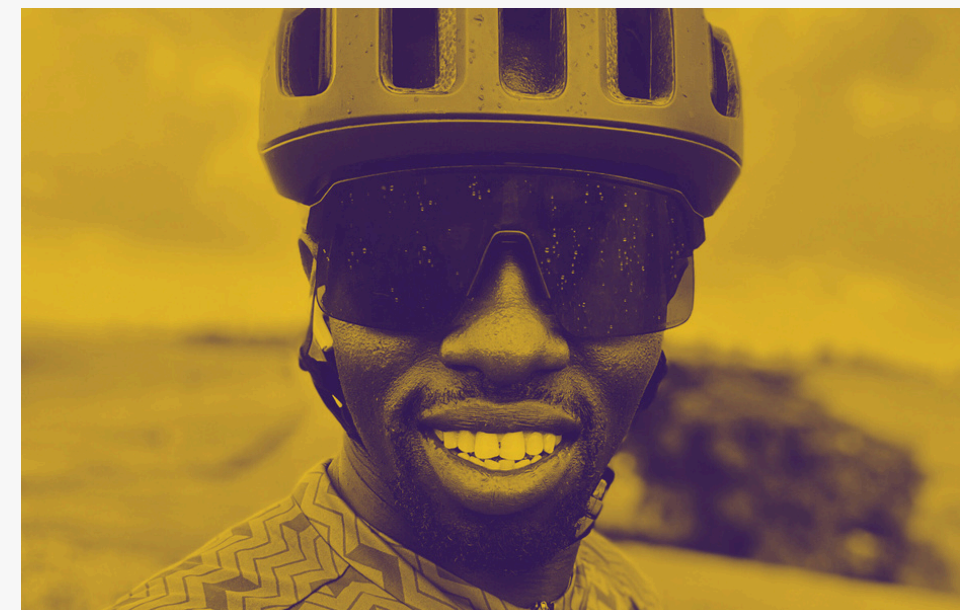

BUDGET ALLOCATION OVERVIEW

Total Funds Raised:

- **10%: Covering ride expenses, including:**
 - Bicycle Maintenance
 - Support Vehicles & Logistics: Vehicle rentals, fuel for escort cars
 - Accommodation & Food: Lodging and meals for the team in India
 - Safety & Medical Support: First aid, medical staff, insurance
 - Marketing & Promotions: Social media ads, press releases, merchandise
 - Admin & Operational Costs: Miscellaneous administrative expenses
 - Contingency Funds: Reserve for unexpected costs
- **90%: Supporting Lions Club of Nairobi Huru Projects:**
 - Braille Readers for Blind Students: Kshs. 70,000 per reader
 - School Feeding Program: Kshs. 20 per meal, feeding 10,000 children daily
 - White Cane Distribution: Kshs. 1,500 per cane
 - Sponsoring Child's Education: Kshs. 25,000 per term per child
